Beginning	During our film in the beginning Nick (father) and David (son) are leisurely walking and then there is dissonance and someone is creeping behind them. The chord quality is major.
Middle	In the middle of our film David face palms and he decides to walk and retrieve his shoe. The masked person is hiding behind the bushes waiting for his prey. We have a crescendo leading up to the attack because we wanted it to feel tense and have a bit of suspense.	There was dissonance when David face palmed. Then a crescendo started. The crescendo ended once he was grabbed. The dynamics are forte once he was grabbed. There was also dissonance when he was grabbed.
End	In the end of our film Nick (father) is looking for his son. There is sad music playing in the background. Nick is pretending to call out David's name and he finds his shoe. He looks into the woods and then slowly stumbles back. Nick starts to cry and then walks away with his head down.	In the end of our film it is minor and very sad sounding.
